





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DEFENCE CONTRACTING

Defence operations in the Pacific face a consistent set of challenges: unreliable local marine operators, limited maintenance capability, and complex logistics across remote island nations. Every unplanned delay—a vessel awaiting repair, a tug that doesn't mobilise on time, a port call without proper support—compounds risk for program managers, PMSP contractors, and naval planners.

Ocean Logistics Limited (OLL) solves these problems by providing dependable tug and barge logistics, vessel maintenance and repair support, MEX/CMMS implementation, landing craft and multi-island logistics, and ship husbandry for naval and defence assets operating across the Pacific.

Ocean Logistics Limited is positioned to support the Australian Defence Force, US Navy, and allied defence contractors across Vanuatu, Fiji, PNG, Solomon Islands, Samoa, Tonga, Kiribati, Tuvalu, and the Cook Islands.

Featured Projects



RVS Sokomanu: Technical Partnership & CMMS
OLL serves as the key maintenance partner for the Vanuatu Police Maritime Wing's RVS Sokomanu.

Beyond routine repairs, we successfully implemented a bespoke Computerised Maintenance Management System (CMMS) for the vessel, shifting the focus from reactive repairs to preventative engineering. This ensures the asset remains operationally ready for national tasking.



Mala Base Naval Infrastructure Upgrade: Acting as the Main Contractor following Cyclones Kevin and Judy, OLL delivered critical civil construction and infrastructure repairs to the Mala Base Wharf.

These upgrades were strategically critical, restoring the base's capacity to berth and support the RVS Sokomanu, directly linking our civil capability to national naval readiness.



RVS Takuare – Salvage & Asset Recovery:
Contracted by the Australian Government, OLL executed the complex salvage of the patrol boat RVS Takuare after its grounding at Tomali, South Epi.

This four-phase operation involved the safe debunkering of 40,777 litres of fuel to prevent environmental damage, followed by a successful refloat and tow to safety using the Tug Huria Matenga.
