Our Specialized Harbour Fleet

To maintain our status as the largest and most capable provider in the country, OLL utilizes a diverse fleet of high-performance tugboats. Our harbour operations are primarily supported by:

- **Tugboat Wistari:** Our flagship 34m ASD vessel, boasting 46TBP (Tons Bollard Pull) for maximum control.
- **Tugboat Huria Matenga:** A 30.5m ASD vessel with 41TBP, designed for high-maneuverability in tight harbour limits.
- **Titirangi & Maungatea:** Modern harbour units that provide the redundancy and resilience needed to support simultaneous port calls.
- **Supporting Units:** Our wider fleet of 9 tugs, including the **Tarpan**, **Melissa**, **Farm Cove**, and **Warringa**, provides the versatile power required for everything from berthing assistance to emergency breakdown response.

Strategic Partnerships with International Liners

Ocean Logistics Limited (OLL) serves as the primary maritime gateway for Vanuatu's international trade. We maintain long-standing, operational partnerships with the world's leading shipping lines, providing the critical tug support required for their regular rotations through Port Vila and Luganville.

Our team is deeply integrated into the logistics chains of these carriers, ensuring that even the largest modern container and multi-purpose vessels are berthed with precision and safety.

Neptune Pacific Direct Line (NPDL): As the primary link to Australia and New Zealand, NPDL relies on OLL for the safe handling of their regional fleet.

Regularly Assists: Capitaine Wallis, NPDL Tahiti, and Takutai Chief




